

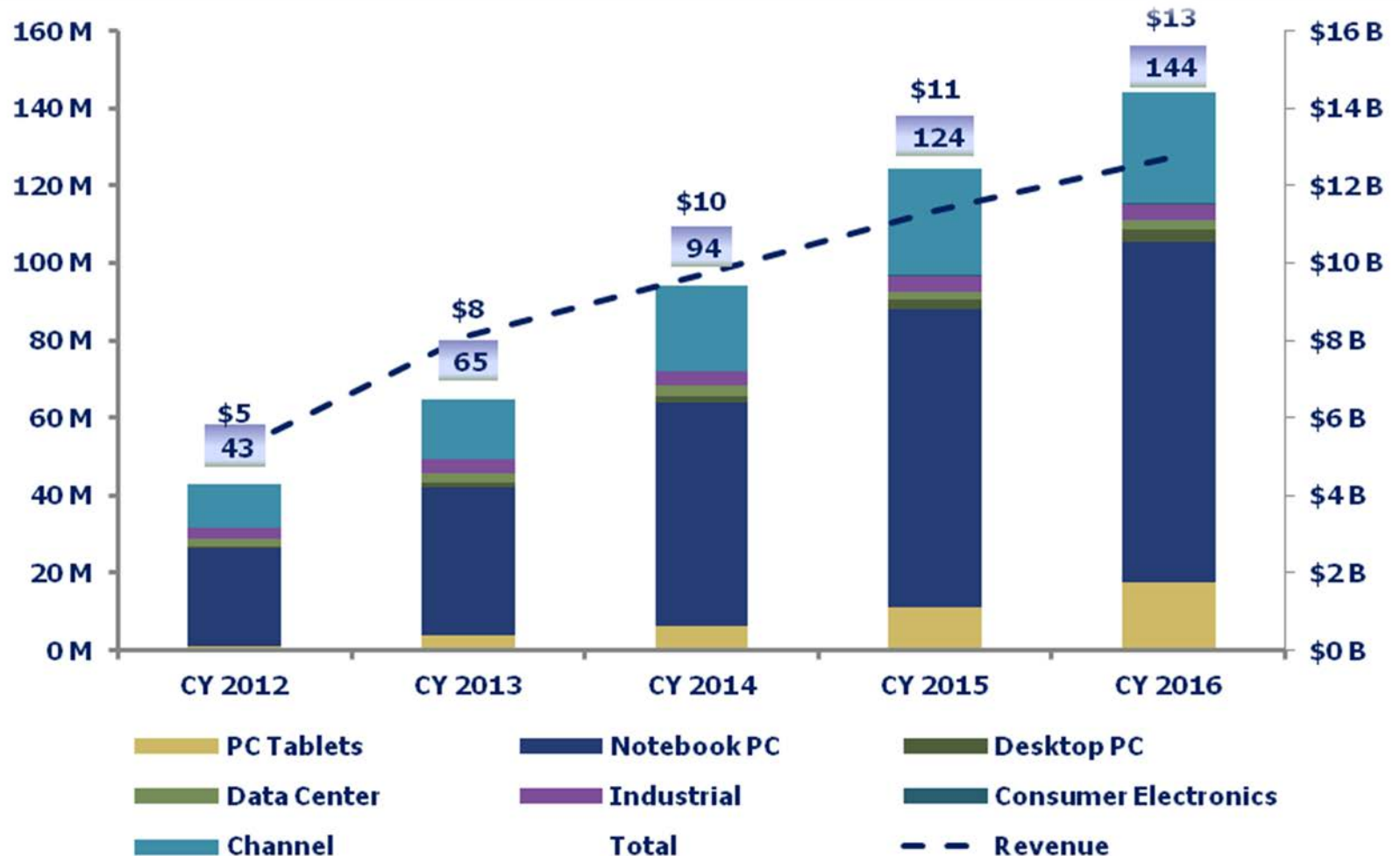

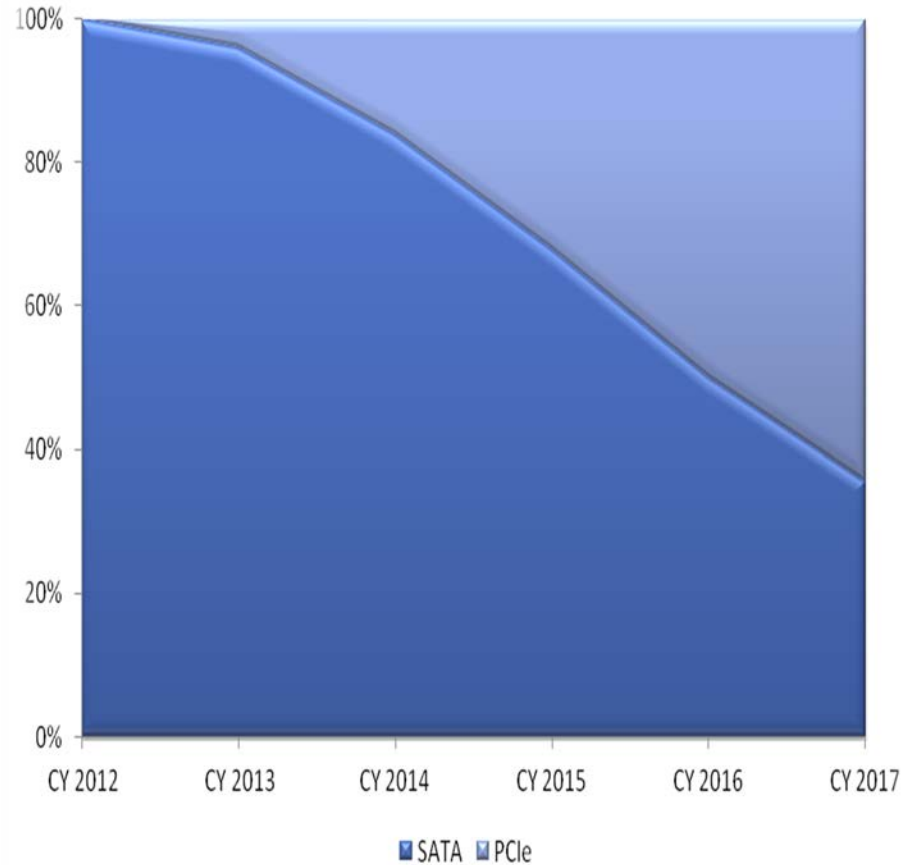
Ultrathin/Notebook and Tablet PCs fueling 47% Client SSD CAGR

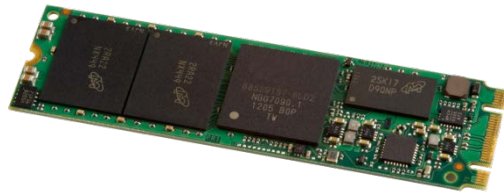

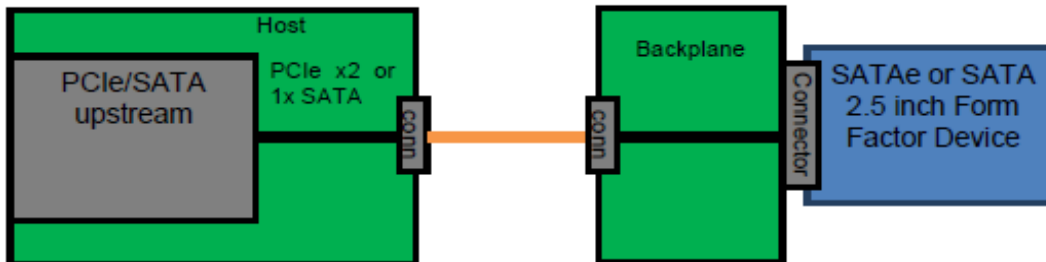
Typical desktop configuration with cable



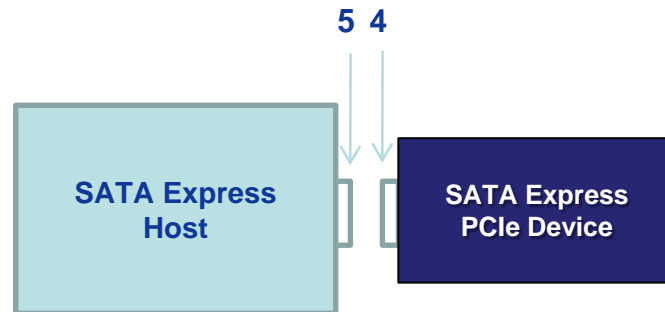
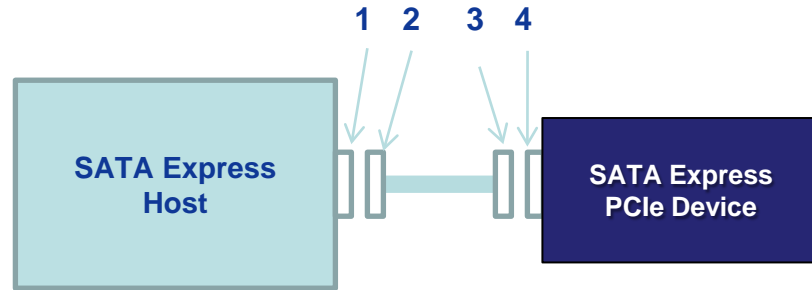
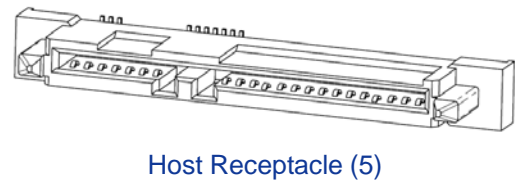
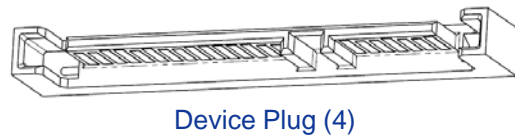
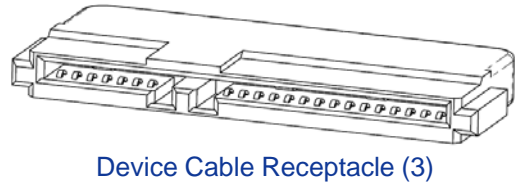
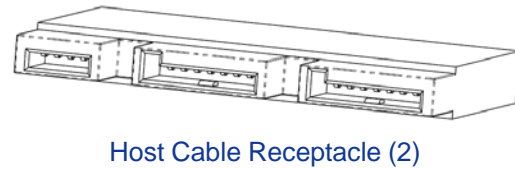
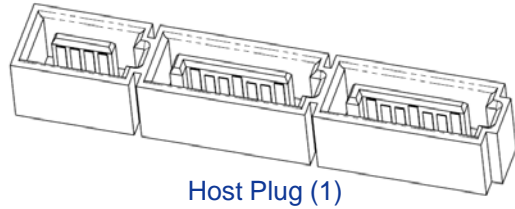
Typical notebook direct-connect configuration



Typical server configuration with cable and backplane

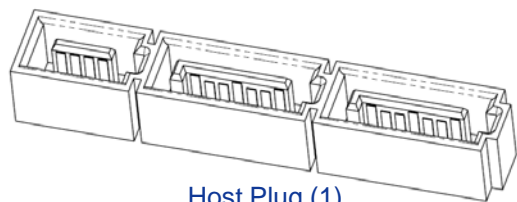

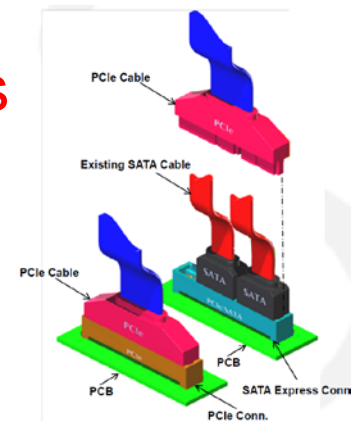

Summary

- Client SSDs saturating the SATA III interface
- New connectors and device form factors aid interface transition from SATA III to PCIe
- Leveraging existing standards to facilitate low-risk, cost-effective transition
- New standards extend Client SSD application base
